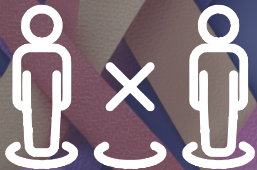
Vaccines Can Prevent Cancer?

HBV Vaccinations

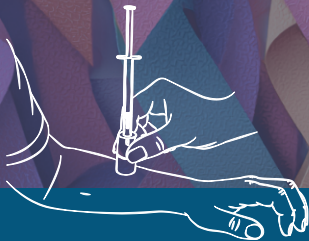
HBV vaccines are highly effective in preventing hepatitis B virus infection, which is a major risk factor for chronic liver disease and liver cancer⁽⁴⁾



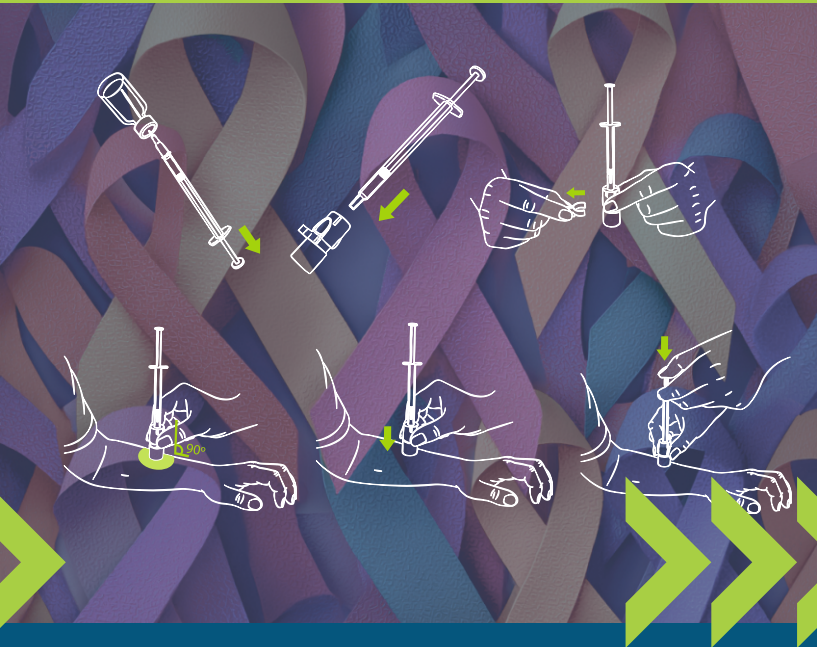
Intradermal Vaccination:
